A public hearing will be held by the Board of Directors of the Cambria Community Services District (CCSD) on December 19, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. at the Veterans' Memorial Building, 1000 Main Street, Cambria, CA, to consider adoption of Ordinance 02-2019. This Ordinance will amend Chapter 6.04 of the Cambrian Community Services District Municipal Code and adopt and amend the 2019 California Fire Code, which is based on the 2018 International Fire Code, the 2018 International Wildland Urban Interface Code as published by the International Code Council, and the 2018 National Fire Protection Association Standard 1144 Standard for Reducing Structure Ignition Hazards from Wildland Fire as published by the International Code Council. Copies of the foregoing codes to be adopted by reference are on file in the Office of the District Clerk of the Cambria Community Services District and are open to public inspection at the CCSD's Offices located at 1316 Tamsen Street, Suite 201, Cambria, CA 93428.

The Board of Directors may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Directors at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the District's Offices located at 1316 Tamsen Street, Suite 201, Cambria, CA 93428 or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
