MOBILE REGISTRATION INTAKE CENTER TO OPEN IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

San Luis Obispo, CA – A Mobile Registration Intake Center (MRIC) will be opening in San Luis Obispo County to assist residents affected by the storms. The mobile center will be staffed by FEMA personnel to register residents for FEMA financial assistance and answer questions about disaster assistance programs.

Address: 1043 Main St, Cambria, CA 93428, parking lot

Dates: Wednesday February 15 and Thursday, February 16 from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM

Residents are encouraged to file insurance claims for damage to their homes, personal property, businesses, and vehicles before they apply for FEMA Assistance. Applications can also be submitted online at <u>disasterassistance.gov</u>. You may also use the <u>FEMA mobile app</u> or call 1-800-621-3362. The line is open every day from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. ET.
