The wet weather has slowed things down, but we're committed to staying productive with important department projects.

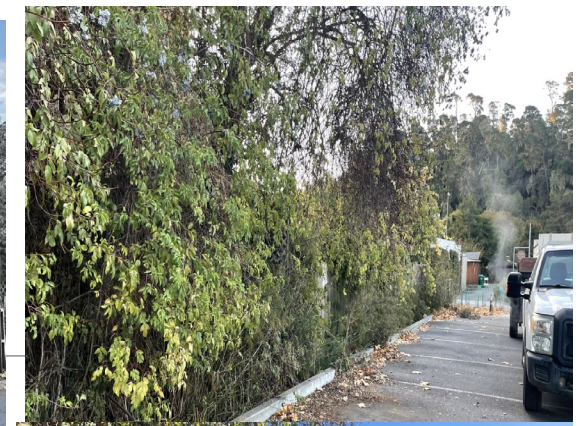
Our team continues patrolling CCSD lots and trails, ensuring district areas are maintained.



Tree Branch & Brush Removal

The F&R crews have been out trimming back tree branches and chipping and mowing small brush. The areas that have been focused on are the Center Street parking lot, Main Street bridge walkway to the East Ranch, Santa Rosa Creek Road, and the picnic area next to the dog park. This has been done with the break in the weather.

Other areas will include the Rodeo Grounds Road between the stairs from Cambria Pines Lodge and Berry Trail, along the East Ranch Santa Rosa Trail surrounding areas.

After the wet weather arrived, we waited to start working on the parking lot. We dropped approximately 24 tons of crushed sand to fill in potholes and low spots. We are still planning to scrap the areas of concern after the following wet weather so it's pliable.



East Ranch Santa Rosa Trail



Before the wet weather arrived, we applied wood chips to the East Ranch Santa Rosa Trail. At this time, over 72 yards of chips have been laid down between the parking lot and the island, and we are still on track to cover that area as well, which leads to Hwy 1.

This will help with future use in wet weather.
